

## dallas PERFORM AT NXNE 1999 IN TORONTO

dallas, the alternative/indie music group from Estonia, has been invited to perform at the NXNE [North By Northeast] 1999 Festival in Toronto in June. This will be the group's second visit to North America, following up their successful concerts at Canadian Music Week in March this year, of which Exclaim! magazine commented: "Estonian pop band Dallas proved that their first show away from home wouldn't be their last."

dallas' self-titled debut CD, released in January 1999, has been praised by the critics. The Toronto Star called it "the best European pop album to land on these shores since The Delgados...." Exclaim! said: ".....just be thankful for the gem of catchy pop." The Toronto Star put dallas on the front page of its Canadian Music Week coverage and said: "it's already tough to imagine a better pop record coming down the pipe this year."

The dallas CD has been well received by radio, with airplay on more than twenty college/community and commercial stations across Canada. Toronto's CFNY/Edge 102 put the spotlight on dallas in its new rock preview feature, and the CD airs regularly on CBC's national music shows Radio Escapade and RadioSonic. The album has reached position #16 in Chart magazine's Top 50 campus airplay chart.
